Here is a list of the supplies I'll be using. Amazon (Affiliate) Links included but please feel free to use any supplies you already have. You will find that you will have less frustration and better results with 100% good quality cotton paper as it will hold up better with this process.

- <u>Arches Watercolor Paper 140lb cold press</u> or any 100% cotton paper.
- Watercolor Paints tubes or pans (<u>Rosa Watercolors</u> Love the vibrancy of these paints)
- <u>DaVinci Round 12</u> For a larger area wash
- Princeton Script 1 smaller details
- I Love the <u>Princeton ¼" dagger brush</u>, but it does take some practice
- <u>Masking Tape</u> My favorite one for not ripping my paper.
- A board to tape down your paper to.
- 2 cups of water (one for dirty and one for clean)
- Hair dryer to speed up the process
- Salt to add texture (recommend playing around with different ones for texture).
